



U.S Department of Energy & SEC to host the Hydrogen Americas Summit in Washington D.C.

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) alongside the Sustainable Energy Council (SEC) are co-hosting the **Hydrogen Americas Summit**, taking place from **10-11 October** at the Omni Shoreham Hotel in Washington DC. The Summit will gather global government representatives, hydrogen and energy stakeholders, service providers and end-users to identify opportunities and get insights into the latest projects and policy developments that will be crucial to drive the Region's industry forward.

Hydrogen will be crucial to achieve a low-carbon energy mix. The recent signing of the Inflation Reduction Act as well as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, including unprecedented funding for the development of clean hydrogen hubs, has further cemented the key role that hydrogen will play in the region's energy transition.
